As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other Old-School Hip Hop tunes.</p>	<p>Round and Round All the learning is focused around one song: Round and Round, a Bossa Nova Latin style. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked.</p>	<p>In the Groove In The Groove is a song that was specially written for classroom use to teach children about different styles of music. This is a very easy song to learn and has been arranged in six different styles; Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. Children will listen and learn a different style of In The Groove.
